Administrative Review Council (ARC)

The Council is examining its conclusions and recommendations in this report further as a result of issues raised by the National Legal Aid Advisory Committee, which is seeking submissions by 21 July 1989 on funding, providing and supplying legal aid services.
- Community Service and Health. Work is progressing on a DP examining review issues in the area of joint Federal/State funding program, and a draft

report on review of decisions involving assessment of products is in preparation. The Council has forwarded letters of advice on both these matter to the Attorney-General.

- Migration. The Council wrote to the Attorney-General on 11 May 1989 providing advice on the review aspects of the Migration Legislation Amendment Bill. By that time the Bill had been introduced into the Senate but had not been debated. The legislation was passed in June 1989 with the review aspects of the Bill substantially unchanged.
- Broadcasting. The Council expects to receive an outline of its DP from the Communciations Law Centre, University of New South Wales, in the next few weeks. The DP will deal with the review of the broadcasting regulations and procedural decisions of the Australian Broadcasting Tribunal.
- Informal rule-making. At its March 1989 meeting the Council agreed to organise a seminar to discuss the current tendency in government agencies to use informal subordinate rule-making in preference to changes to the legislation. Arrangements are currently being made to hold the seminar at Parliament House on 31 August 1989.
