
— *Contributory Negligence in Fatal Accident Cases and Breach of Statutory Duty Cases and Funeral Costs in Fatal Accident Cases, 1985*; (ALRC 32) *Community Law Reform in the ACT: Second Report — Loss of Consortium and Compensation for Loss of Capacity to the Housework, 1986* and (ALRC 42) *Occupiers' Liability*. The committee has prepared a report on each.

Occupiers' liability

The ACTCLRC agreed with the ALRC's recommendations on occupiers' liability and the ACT

Government passed The Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Amendment Act 1991 (ACT) which implements the ALRC's recommendations. Any doubts about a landlord's responsibilities in negligence for defective premises arising out of the 1906 House of Lords decision *Cavalier v Pope* have been removed by the new legislation which says a landlord can indeed be liable in negligence.

Loss of consortium and negligence

The ACTCLRC also agreed with the ALRC's recommendations on

loss of consortium and aspects of negligence and has recommended they be implemented by the ACT Government.
