

## Obituary

### THE LATE ALAN KEITH EEDY

IT is with deep regret that we record the death on 28 July 1988 of Mr Alan Keith Eedy, a Councillor of the Institute.

Mr Eedy was elected a Foundation Member of the Institute in 1976. In 1985 he was elected to the Council of the Institute and was a member of the New South Wales Chapter Committee since 1977, serving as Vice-Chairman 1980-81 and Chapter Chairman 1982-84.

In addition to being a Fellow of the Institute, Mr Eedy was a Fellow of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects, a qualified Building Inspector—Local Government (NSW) and a Justice of the Peace.

Mr Eedy's professional career was in architecture (except for a period when he was on war service) in which he practised as a sole practitioner in Sydney. Arbitrations were part of his professional practice. As well as being a Graded Arbitrator by the Institute he was an approved arbitrator of the Master Builders Association of NSW and the Builders Licensing Board (NSW).

Members will join Councillors in mourning the passing of Alan and will remember his contribution towards the development of the Institute and its reputation, not only in New South Wales but throughout Australia.
