# Manuals to have "On-Cite"

At first year level most students are made aware of the correct citation procedures required by their particular law school Many schools prepare their own style guides or refer students to some of the many style manuals available such as The Chicago Manual of Style, MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers or the Uniform System of Citation

These major standard style/citation manuals however do not cover in any substantial detail areas such as government publications/resources, electronic sources or non-book works such as radio or television broadcasts or video documentaries

The following three books are major contributors to the closing of this existing gap in the area of citation:

The Complete Guide to Citing Government Information Resources: a Manual for Writers and Librarians, received high acclaim from its many reviewers when first published in 1984 This positive reception was one of the factors which prompted its authors to produce a second and revised edition. The second factor was supplied by the introduction and widespread use of electronic sources into the commercial, government, and academic arena within the last ten years. A corresponding citation manual for this particular material has been sorely needed for some time

Legal librarians and legal writers will welcome the revised edition of *The Complete* 

Guide Its purpose is fourfold: to identify and differentiate; to indicate intellectual quality; to give credit to the ideas of other authors; and to locate cited items

As in the first edition, the new edition has noted that legal citations are required to follow a certain style by schools or publishers and recommend the use of citation manuals such as *A Uniform System of Citation* or other relevant manuals prescribed by each law school

Apart from the new content in this manual citations of countries other than the United States (chapter 5), and citations for electronic sources (chapter 6), the manual offers the reader a simplicity and innovation of style not readily available in other manuals Together with an excellent glossary of specialist terms and clear illustrations depicting the location of the various parts of the item which are to be cited these features make *The Complete Guide* a valuable source of reference.

The citation manual Electronic Style: A Guide to Citing Electronic Information explains citation methods for the complete range of electronic formats, including full text and bibliographic databases; electronic journals, and discussion lists available on the Internet; e-mail; bulletin board systems and commercial online documents

The style used here is that of the American Psychological Association (APA) However deviation from that style occurs in the instance of legal citations when use is made of the *Uniform System of Citation*. The manual states in its introduction that wherever possible items cited in the legal section are also listed in a section that conforms to APA style, and reference is made to the alternate form

The third citation manual is a 1990 Australian publication Citing Non-Book Materials: A Guide for Researchers and Students. The importance of this 34 page manual lies in the fact that it explains the citation method for referring to a radio or television broadcast, documentary video and advertisements (p 19) The latter may be of importance to writers pursuing the area of copyright or patents.

The three manuals emphasise, as part of their citation principles, the need for precision, clarity and information with regard to location However it is worth noting a statement in *The Complete Guide* "While we would never say that style is unimportant we would say that the anxiety caused by the demand for correct form is entirely out of proportion with its worth Furthermore, when the quest for correct form causes one to omit necessary content, the integrity of the citation is sacrificed While punctuation, capitalization, spacing, etc are important, they can be modified, as necessary, to ensure clarity of content."

Despite this sensible edict those who do worry about the etiquette of style will find that the three manuals will provide a panacea for their anxiety
