The Multi Access Layer Technology (MALT) used by TimeBase provides point-in-time location of legislation, contemporary cases and commentary.

MALT application and products are in development but have already been applied to Corporations Law covering the last six years. GST and Income Tax are following. The commentaries for both are being prepared. At present the time frame for the MALTed version is seven years. The service is available on CD with an Internet version due in October 2000.
