Priority legislation

Many bills (proposed laws) are expected to be introduced into the House of Representatives during this Autumn period of sittings. These include a number of bills with high priority for debate and passage. The high priority bills are listed below. This list is indicative only and other high priority bills may be added. Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry

Dairy Industry Adjustment Bill Dairy Adjustment Levy Bill

- amend the Dairy Produce Act 1986 to provide for the implementation and administration of an adjustment package to assist the dairy industry to manage the structural adjustment process to a deregulated domestic market milk sector;
- provide for a levy on drinking milk at the retail level to fund the adjustment package.

implement a Product Stewardship System for Waste Oil.

Family and Community Services

A New Tax System (Family Assistance) (Consequential and Related Measures) Bill

 provide for the consolidation of family assistance legislation, including the payment infrastructure for childcare benefit, into the A New Tax System (Family Assistance) Act 1999 and the A New Tax System (Family Assistance) (Administration) Act 1999.

Family and Community Services Legislation Amendment (Further 1999 Budget Measures) Bill

 provide for the implementation of measures relating to the simplification of international payments and the use of tax file numbers as the primary matching key for matching Centrelink data with particular Australian Taxation Office data.

Transport and Regional Services

Road Transport Charges (Australian Capital Territory) Amendment Bill

- implement updated nationally uniform heavy vehicle charges for the Australian Capital Territory and Federally registered vehicles;
