SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

In preparing articles for submission authors should be guided by the following points:

- 1. Submissions may be made via email to: <sarah.wickham@ adelaide.edu.au>. A hard copy should be posted to: The Editor, Adelaide Law Review, School of Law, The University of Adelaide, SA 5005.
- 2. Authors are expected to check the accuracy of all references in the manuscript before submission. It is not always possible to submit proofs for correction.
- 3. Biographical details should be starred (*) and precede the footnotes. They should include the author's academic qualifications and current employment.
- 4. The journal has adopted the *Australian Guide to Legal Citation*, published by the Melbourne University Law Review Association Inc. A copy can be found on their website:

- 5. An abstract of between 150 and 200 words should also be included with the submitted article.
- 6. If the submitted article is accepted by the Adelaide Law Review, it will be published in both the traditional Law Review and electronically.
