This issue of *Admin Review* comprises a bibliography of articles published from 1980 to date dealing with matters of public law. The list is not intended to be comprehensive but should provide a good basis for further research. The choice of articles for this list emphasises the matters of central concern to the Administrative Review Council, namely the operation of the system of Federal administrative law in Australia. There are also some articles dealing with administrative law in other contexts.

Subject to exceptions for articles of central concern to the Council, articles of less than about 4 pages in length have been screened out of the list. This was done to focus the list on more substantial works and to keep the list to a manageable length. The listing of articles by subject is intended to make the list more useful than one which simply lists all the articles alphabetically by author. A full list of subject headings has been included so that related subjects can be readily checked. Together with the list of authors and references to the articles the authors have written, the article list should be a useful research tool.
