Jeffrey Samuels' involvement in Australian contemporary urban Aboriginal art has spanned 30 years. Jeffrey experimented creatively with Aboriginal cultural items to develop his own style through understanding and learning Aboriginal art and culture. He is a co-founding member of the Aboriginal contemporary art space Boomalli Aboriginal Artist Cooperative Limited that is located in Leichhardt, Sydney. He has been a muralist, an Aboriginal artist-in-residence and has held art workshops as an Aboriginal art teacher in private and public schools, TAFE, universities and in Australian gaols. His art has been exhibited in Australian Aboriginal contemporary art exhibitions nationally and internationally and has works in Public and Private Collections in Australia and overseas. Jeffrey considers one of the high points in his long distinguished artistic career was to have his painting re-created in the 'Nature Segment' of the opening ceremony of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games.
