Customs STYLE

Australian Customs Service is adopting a new uniform and corporate wardrobe. The new, readily identifiable uniforms, with their bright blue shirt and 'Customs' shoulder patches will be in use across Australia by early next year.

The range comprises a distinctive uniform for Customs border officers and a corporate wardrobe which draws on style elements of the uniform.

All components of the uniforms and corporate wardrobe are being made in Australia. Some fabrics were imported because they were unavailable here.

The styles and colour schemes reflect extensive staff consultations. The uniforms are based on deep blue tops and dresses, charcoal grey bottoms and navy knitwear. The corporate wardrobe colour scheme is based on charcoal grey bottoms and jackets with burgundy knitwear with a variety of contrasting fabric designs and colours in shirts, blouses and dresses.
