## 21ST ANNIVERSARY OF MONASH UNIVERSITY LAW SCHOOL

In 1985, the Monash University Law School celebrated its 21st Anniversary since its foundation in 1964. The anniversary was celebrated by a dinner held in the Great Hall of the National Gallery of Victoria on 20th June, 1985. The guest speaker was the Governor General of Australia, who presented the main address and His Excellency has kindly given his permission to publish that address in this issue of the Law Review as a record of the celebration of the 21st Anniversary by the Law School.
