- *Inspirational stories*: life — the book you have always wanted to read/stormy journey, success-

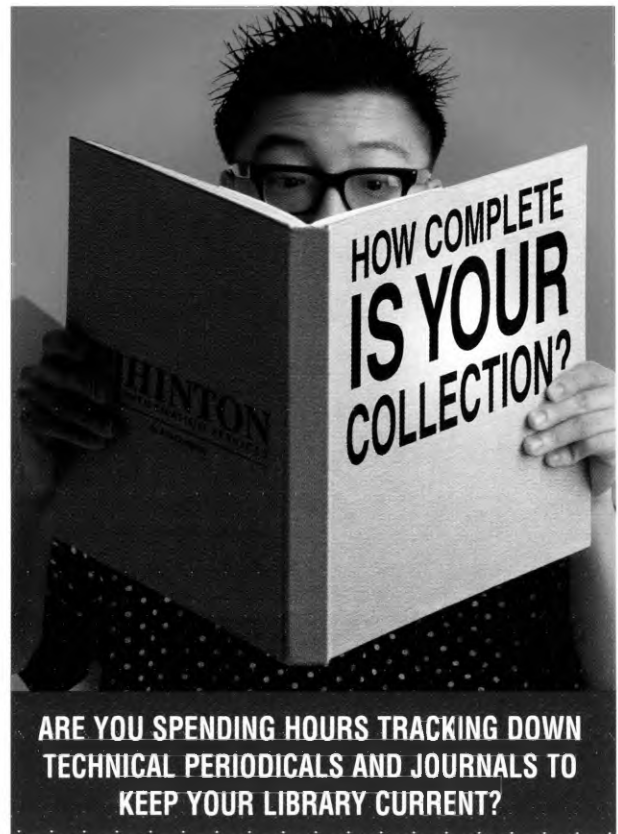
ful arrival: development of combined library/e-Learn centre.
