THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 21 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919 and
for other purposes.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the
Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal
Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the
Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the *Seat of Govern-
ment (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1937*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1937*.

2. After section forty-seven of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

“48. The Minister may make regulations not inconsistent with this Ordinance prescribing all matters which by this Ordinance are required or permitted to be prescribed or which are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for giving effect to this Ordinance.” Power to make regulations.

3. The Rabbit Destruction Regulations made on the twenty-fifth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and twenty, under the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919*, shall continue in full force and effect as if made under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance. Saving.
