No. 1 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Rates Ordinance 1926-1931, as amended
by the Seat of Government (Administration)
Ordinance, 1930-1933.

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and
over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the
Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred
by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of
Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rates Ordinance*, Short title and
1937. citation.

(2.) The *Rates Ordinance* 1926-1931, as amended by the *Seat
of Government (Administration) Ordinance* 1930-1933, is in this
Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance,
may be cited as the *Rates Ordinance* 1926-1937.

2. Section fifteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Rates to be
omitting from sub-section (4.) the word "Ten" and inserting in paid by the
its stead the word "eight". owner.
