# THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

### No. 1 of 1937.

## AN ORDINANCE

#### To amend the Rates Ordinance 1926-1931, as amended by the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance, 1930-1933.

**B** it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

**1**.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rates Ordinance*, Short title and 1937.

(2.) The Rates Ordinance 1926-1931, as amended by the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1933, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Rates Ordinance* 1926-1937.

2. Section fifteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Rates to be omitting from sub-section (4.) the word "Ten" and inserting in  $_{owner.}^{paid by the}$  its stead the word "eight".
