- 1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution Alteration (Ecology, Diversity and Sustainability) Act 1995.
- Parliament to take into account ecology, diversity and sustainability
  - **2.** Section 51 of the Constitution is altered by adding at the end the following paragraph:
  - "When making a law under this section each House of the Parliament must take into account the probable effects (if any) of that law on:
    - (i) the maintenance of ecosystems and of essential ecological processes;
    - (ii) the biological diversity of Australia; and
