FOR

**An Act to amend the *Marriage Act 1961* and the *Family Law Act 1975* in consequence of the enactment of the *Domicile Act 1981***

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the *Domicile (Consequential Amendments) Act 1981*.

**Commencement**

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which the *Domicile Act 1981* comes into operation.

**Amendment of Marriage Act 1961**

3. Section 5 of the *Marriage Act 1961*<sup>1</sup> is amended by omitting sub-section (4).

**Amendment of Family Law Act 1975**

4. Section 4 of the *Family Law Act 1975*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting sub-section (3).
