A BILL FOR

AN ACT to pass the authority for regulation of prohibited guns from the Police Minister to the Commissioner for Police.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS there exist in the hands of the general public in Tasmania high-powered and rapid-fire weapons with a military application;

AND WHEREAS such weapons present a danger to the wider community and have no place in a civilised society;

AND WHEREAS the Minister for Police refuses or has failed to exercise the power bestowed to him by section 4 of the Guns Act 1991 to prohibit such weapons.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Guns Amendment Act 1995.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day it receives the Royal assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Guns Act 1991 is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Act

- 4-Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended:-
 - (a) by omitting the word "Minister" from subsection (2) and inserting the word "Commissioner" in its place; and
 - (b) by omitting subsections (4) and (5).
