An Act to amend the Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992 to provide for local government councillors in relation to the operation of that Act

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) (Exemption of Council Allowances) Amendment Act 1993.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992.

2 Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) (Exemption of Council Allowances) Amendment No. . 1993

Interpretation: salary or wages not to include a councillor's allowances

- 4. Section 11 of the Principal Act is amended:
 - (a) by omitting "or (10)" from paragraph (1)(e);
 - (b) by adding the following word and paragraph after paragraph (1)(e):
 - "; and
 - (f) remuneration of a person referred to in paragraph 12(10)(a) but not an allowance referred to in paragraph 12(10)(b).".

Interpretation: employee not to include certain councillors

- 5. Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (10) and substituting the following subsection:
 - "(10) A person who holds office as a member of a local government council: 15
 - (a) is an employee of the council if the person receives salary or wages by virtue of holding that office;
 - (b) is not an employee of the council if the person receives no remuneration other than an allowance for attendance at council meetings.".
