## A BILL

FOR

**An Act to amend the *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992* to provide for local government councillors in relation to the operation of that Act**

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

### **Short title**

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) (Exemption of Council Allowances) Amendment Act 1993*.

### **Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

### **Principal Act**

- 10 3. In this Act, “**Principal Act**” means the *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992*.

2 *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) (Exemption of Council Allowances)*  
*Amendment No. , 1993*

**Interpretation: salary or wages not to include a councillor's allowances**

4. Section 11 of the Principal Act is amended:

- (a) by omitting "or (10)" from paragraph (1)(e);
- (b) by adding the following word and paragraph after paragraph (1)(e): 5

“; and

- (f) remuneration of a person referred to in paragraph 12(10)(a) but not an allowance referred to in paragraph 12(10)(b).”.

**Interpretation: employee not to include certain councillors**

5. Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (10) and substituting the following subsection:

“(10) A person who holds office as a member of a local government council: 15

- (a) is an employee of the council if the person receives salary or wages by virtue of holding that office;
- (b) is not an employee of the council if the person receives no remuneration other than an allowance for attendance at council meetings.”. 20
