# A BILL

#### FOR

## An Act to amend the Superannuation Supervisory Levy Act 1992

The Parliament of Australia enacts:

### Short title etc.

5

**1.(1)** This Act may be cited as the Superannuation Supervisory Levy Amendment Act 1992.

(2) In this Act, "**Principal Act**" means the Superannuation Supervisory Levy Act 1991<sup>1</sup>.

#### Commencement

2. This Act commences on the same day as section 21 of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1992.

#### 10 Amendment of title

3. The title of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "Occupational Superannuation Standards Act 1987" and substituting "Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1992".

## 2 Superannuation Supervisory Levy Amendment No. , 1992

4. Section 3 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted:

## Application of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act

"3. Section 6, and Division 2 of Part 1, of the *Superannuation Industry* (*Supervision*) *Act 1992* apply in relation to this Act in a corresponding way 5 to the way in which they apply in relation to that Act.".

### Interpretation

5. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "required return lodgment day" and substituting the following definition:

" 'required return lodgment day', in relation to a return, means the last day by which the return is required to be lodged under section 21 of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1992.".

### Imposition of superannuation supervisory levy

6. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "Occupational 15 Superannuation Standards" and substituting "Superannuation Entities (Taxation)".
