## An Act to amend the law relating to veterans' affairs, and for related purposes

The Parliament of Australia enacts:

#### PART 1—PRELIMINARY

#### **Short title**

5

1. This Act may be cited as the Veterans' Affairs Legislation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1993.

#### Commencement

- 2.(1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), this Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) Division 2 of Part 2 commences immediately after Division 19 of Part 2 of the Social Security Legislation Amendment Act (No. 3) 1992.

(3) Division 4 of Part 2 commences on 1 January 1994.

## Division 1—Preliminary

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 <sup>1</sup> .	
Division 2—Allocated pensions	
Index of definitions	
4. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following	10
entries in the index after the entry for "allied veteran":	
"Allocated annuity 5J(9)	
Allocated pension 5J(9)".	
Investment income definitions	
5. Section 5J of the Principal Act is amended:	15
(a) by inserting the following definitions in subsection (1):	
" 'allocated annuity' has the meaning given by subsection (9);	
'allocated pension' has the meaning given by subsection (9);";	
(b) by adding at the end of subsection (1B) the following paragraph:	
"; (g) an allocated pension or allocated annuity.";	20
(c) by inserting after paragraph (1C)(e) the following paragraphs:	
"; (f) an immediate annuity that is not an allocated annuity;	
(g) a superannuation pension that is not an allocated pension.";	
(d) by adding at the end of subsection (1C) the following Notes:	
"Note 4: An immediate annuity is dealt with under sections 46T and 52A.	25
Note 5: A superannuation pension is dealt with under sections 46U and 52.	
Note 6: For 'allocated annuity' and 'allocated pension' see subsection (9).";	
(e) by adding at the end the following subsection:	
"(9) A pension or annuity is an allocated one if either:	
(a) the rate of payment of the pension or annuity; or	30
(b) the basis for variations in the rate of payment of the pension or annuity;	
is not fully defined in the relevant trust deed or contract.".

6. Section 52 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (1)(d) "that is not an allocated pension" after "person".

- 7. Section 52A of the Principal Act is amended:
- (a) by inserting after paragraph (2)(a) the following paragraph: "(aa) an allocated annuity; or";
- (b) by inserting after subsection (4) (and before the annuity value calculator) the following subsection:
  - "(5) Subsection (4) does not apply to an allocated annuity.
  - Note 1: For 'allocated annuity' see subsection 5J(9).
  - Note 2: Allocated annuities are treated as managed investments (see paragraph 5J(1B)(g) and Subdivision AA of Division 8 of this Part).".

#### Division 3—Shares and other listed securities

#### Investment income definitions

**8.** Section 5J of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "in Australia" from the definition of "listed security" in subsection (1).

### Division 4—Veterans' Children Education Scheme

### Interpretation

- 9. Section 116 of the Principal Act is amended:
- (a) by inserting "22(4) or" after "subsection" in subparagraph (b)(i) of the definition of "eligible child of a member of the Forces, or of a member of a Peacekeeping Force" in subsection (1);
- (b) by inserting "22(4) or" after "subsection" in subparagraph (a)(ii) of the definition of "eligible child of a veteran" in subsection (1);
- (c) by inserting "22(4) or" after "subsection" in subparagraph (b)(i) of the definition of "eligible child of a veteran" in subsection (1).

## 25 PART 3—EXTENSION OF ADVANCE PHARMACEUTICAL ALLOWANCE

## Repeal of Division 2 of Part VIIA

10. Section 17 of the Veterans' Affairs Legislation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1991 is amended by omitting "1 January 1994" and substituting "1 January 1995".

## Eligibility for advance pharmaceutical allowance

- 11. Section 118F of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* is amended by adding at the end of subsection (1) the following Note:
- "Note: This Division is subject to a sunset provision: see section 17 of the *Veterans'*35

  Affairs Legislation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1991. The Division is due to be repealed on 1 January 1995.".
