An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for such vear.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble, and the House of Paymontain Control of Control of Paymontain Control of Paymontain Control of Control and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1922-23.

Short title.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted fit,542.293. to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three the sum of Fourteen million five hundred and forty-two thousand two hundred and ninety-three pounds.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund \$20,884,378. towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Twenty million eight hundred and eighty-four thousand and three hundred and seventyeight pounds are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 1 of 1922 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.
