

## APPROPRIATION 1928-29.

### No. 48 of 1928.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for such year.

[Assented to 28th September, 1928.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act 1928-29*. Short title.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine the sum of Sixteen million six hundred and forty-nine thousand two hundred and ninety-two pounds. Issue and application of £16,649,292.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Act mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Twenty-two million nine hundred and ninety-two thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven pounds are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first of July One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine. Appropriation of supplies £22,992,927.
