An Act to amend the Audit Act 1901-1950.

[Assented to 6th November, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Audit Act 1952.

Short title. and citation.

- (2.) The Audit Act 1901-1950*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Audit Act 1901-1952.
- 2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the Commencement first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.
- 3. Section four of the Audit Act 1901–1950 is amended by omitting salary of the words "Three thousand two hundred and fifty" and inserting in Auditor-General. their stead the words "Three thousand three hundred and fifty".
