APPROPRIATION 1958-59.

No. 60 of 1958.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund sums for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for that year.

[Assented to 8th October, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1958-59. Short title.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Issue and application of £237,609,000.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, the sum of Two hundred and thirty-seven million six hundred and nine thousand pounds.

Appropriation of supply £471,970,000.

4. All sums granted by section three of this Act and by the other Act mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fiftynine, amounting as appears by that Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Four hundred and seventy-one million nine hundred and seventy thousand pounds are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.

Issue, application and appropriation of further £102,000,000.

- 5.—(1.) In addition to the sum referred to in section three of this Act, the Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fiftynine, the sum of One hundred and two million pounds.
- (2.) The sum granted by the last preceding sub-section is appropriated for the purposes of the Loan Consolidation and Investment Reserve established by the Loan Consolidation and Investment Reserve Act 1955.
