## Appropriation (No. 2) 1967-68

## No. 67 of 1967

An Act to appropriate a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for certain expenditure in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight.

[Assented to 31 October 1967]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonweith of Antonia the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act (No. 2) 1967-68. Short utile.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commence the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund Issue and and apply for the services specified in the Second Schedule to this Act, application of \$366,461,000. in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, the sum of Three hundred and sixty-six million, four hundred and sixty-one thousand dollars.

4. The sums authorized by the Supply Act (No. 2) 1967-68 and by this Appropriation Act to be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, amounting, as score, 559,000. appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of Six hundred and one million, five hundred and fifty-nine thousand dollars are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated. as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, for the services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in respect of the financial year that commenced on that date.
