No. 81 of 1968

An Act to appropriate a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for certain expenditure in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia. as follows:--

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act (No. 2) 1968-69. Short title.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencethe Royal Assent.
- 3. Act to be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of Five hundred and ninety-seven million, one hundred and eighty-six thousand dollars are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight for the services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act in respect of the financial year that commenced on that date.
