APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) 1914-15.

No. 21 of 1914.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and fifteen and to appropriate the Supplies granted for such year in this and the last preceding Session of the Parliament, for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 12th December, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Works and short title. Buildings) Act 1914-15.
- 2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue application of application of £2,756,575. Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen, the sum of Two million seven hundred and fifty-six thousand five hundred and seventy-five pounds.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Acts mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue of supplies, £4,140,345. Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty amounting, as appears by the said Schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of Four million one hundred and forty thousand three hundred and forty-five pounds are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 3 of 1914 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule.
