POST AND TELEGRAPH RATES.

No. 24 of 1918.

An Act to amend the Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902-1913.

[Assented to 19th October, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1918.
- (2). The Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902-1913 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902-1918.
- commencement. 2. This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by Proclamation.
