

Amendment of
the Schedule.

9. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting, after the word “that” (first occurring), the words “, subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,”;
- (b) by inserting, after the word “extract”, the words “, or cause to be extracted by tribute or otherwise,”; and
- (c) by inserting, after paragraph (e), the following words:—

“This application is made upon the following conditions:—

- (1) ^IWe shall be entitled at any time, on giving three months’ notice in writing to the Minister, to revoke the above undertaking; and
- (2) On the expiration of the term of the said notice ^{my}_{our} registration as a gold producer shall cease and determine and thereupon ^IWe shall not unless and until ^{I am}We are again registered as a gold producer be entitled to any of the benefits provided by the said Act or be subject in any way to the provisions of the said Act.”.

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King’s Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Works and Buildings) Act 1931-1932.*

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two the sum of Eight hundred and twenty-nine thousand and seventy-seven pounds.

Issue and application of £829,077.

3. The said sum granted by this Act is appropriated for the purposes and services set forth in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two and to appropriate the Supplies granted by the Parliament for such year.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act 1931-32.*

Short title.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two the sum of Nineteen million five hundred and eighty-six thousand one hundred and eleven pounds.

Issue and application of £19,586,111.

3. All sums granted by this Act and the other Act mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand
