

Australian Capital Territory Evidence (Temporary Provisions)

No. 66 of 1971

**An Act to make temporary provision for the Law of Evidence
in the Australian Capital Territory.**

[Assented to 26 August 1971]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Australian Capital Territory Evidence (Temporary Provisions) Act* 1971.

Commence-

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the nineteenth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-one.

3. The provisions of the *Australian Capital Territory Evidence Ordinance* 1971 contained in Australian Capital Territory Ordinance No. 4 of 1971 shall, notwithstanding its disallowance by the Senate, continue in force until the thirty-first day of March, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two.
