## AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY SUPREME COURT.

## No. 36 of 1955.

An Act to amend the Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court Act 1933-1950, as amended by the Judges' Remuneration Act 1955.

[Assented to 16th June, 1955.]

[Date of commencement, 14th July, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:---

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Australian Capital Territory Short title and citetion. Supreme Court Act 1955.

- (2.) The Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court Act 1933-1950,\* as amended by the Judges' Remuneration Act 1955,† is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Second Schedule to the Judges' Remuneration Act 1955 is amended by omitting the words
  - ustralian Capital Territory | Australian Capital Territory Supreme Supreme Court Act 1933-1950 | Court Act 1933-1955." "Australian Capital
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court Act 1933-1955.
- 2. Section fifty-one of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Appeals from from paragraphs (a) and (b) of sub-section (1.) the words "Three in civil cases. hundred pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand five hundred pounds ".
