- 3. After section one hundred and fifty-one A of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:
- "151B.--(1.) Where the Governor-General, in pursuance of any conditions power conferred by any other Act, by proclamation declares that the Intermediate Tariff shall apply to such goods specified in the proclamation as are the produce or manufacture of the country specified in the proclamation, those goods shall be deemed to be the produce or manufacture of that country if they are produced or manufactured as prescribed or if such conditions as are prescribed are complied with in respect of those goods, and they are not goods to which, by reason of their compliance with the conditions prescribed by this Act or otherwise for the application of rates of duty lower than the Intermediate Tariff, such lower rates of duty apply.

"(2.) In this section, 'Intermediate Tariff' means the rates of duty set out in the column headed 'Intermediate Tariff' in the schedule to any Act imposing duties of Customs, in respect of goods in relation to which the expression is used.".
