

COTTON BOUNTY.

No. 24 of 1958.

An Act to amend the *Cotton Bounty Act 1951-1957*.

[Assented to 21st May, 1958.]

[Date of commencement, 18th June, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Cotton Bounty Act 1958*. Short title and citation.
 - (2.) The *Cotton Bounty Act 1951-1957** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
 - (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Cotton Bounty Act 1951-1958*.
2. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand nine hundred and sixty-three". Specification of bounty.

Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words “the period of eight years commencing with the year One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one” and inserting in their stead the words “the period of seven years that commenced with the year One thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven”.
