## CHILD ENDOWMENT.

## No. 10 of 1945.

An Act to amend the *Child Endowment Act 1941-1942.*

[Assented to 27th June, 1945.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

**1.**—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Child Endowment Act 1945.*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Child Endowment Act 1941-1942\**, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Child Endowment Act 1941-1945.*

**2.** This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Commencement.

**3.** Section thirteen of the *Child Endowment Act 1941-1942* is amended by omitting from sub-sections (1.), (1A.) and (1B.) the words "Five shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "Seven shillings and sixpence".

Child endowment.

**4.** The amendments effected by this Act shall apply in respect of the endowment period commencing on the twenty-sixth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, and in respect of all subsequent endowment periods.

Application of amendments.
