COMMONWEALTH EMPLOYEES' FURLOUGH.

No. 12 of 1958.

An Act to amend the Commonwealth Employees' Furlough Act 1943-1953.

[Assented to 14th May, 1958.]

PE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the B Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Commonwealth Emplovees' Furlough Act 1958.
- (2.) The Commonwealth Employees' Furlough Act 1943–1953,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Commonwealth Employees' Furlough Act 1943-1958.

- 2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight.
- 3. Section nine of the Commonwealth Employees' Furlough *Act* 1943–1953 is repealed.
- 4. The amendment made by this Act does not apply to, or in relation to, a person who, having been a Commonwealth employee, died, or otherwise ceased to be a Commonwealth employee, before the thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight.
