E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Short title Preference) 1949.

- (2.) The Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1948*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1949.
- 2. The Schedule to the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1948 is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are hereby imposed in accordance with the firstmentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (No. 2) 1949.
- (2.) The Customs Tariff 1933-1948*, as amended by the Customs Tariff 1949†, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) Section one of the Customs Tariff 1949 is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff 1933-1949.
