

EXCISE TARIFF VALIDATION.

No. 87 of 1952.

An Act to provide for the Validation of
Collections of Duties of Excise under Excise
Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 6th November, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Excise Tariff Validation Act* Short title.
