No. 30 of 1914.

An Act to authorize the raising and expending of the sum of Two million pounds for the construction of a Railway from Kalgoorlie to Port Augusta.

[Assented to 21st December, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Loan Act 1914*. Short title.
2. The Treasurer may from time to time under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1913* or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Two million pounds. Treasurer
may borrow
£2,000,000.
3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the construction of a railway from Kalgoorlie to Port Augusta. Purpose for
