# LOAN.

#### No. 19 of 1945.

### An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of a certain Sum of Money.

#### [Assented to 3rd August, 1945.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :--

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it

Authority to borrow £150,000,000. **3.** The Treasurer may, from to time, borrow, under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act* 1911–1943, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of One hundred and fifty million pounds.

4. The amount borrowed may be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations made, or to be made, by law.

5. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any loan raised under the authority of this Act, or of any other Act, the sum of One hundred and fifty million pounds for war purposes.

## PAPUA-NEW GUINEA PROVISIONAL ADMINISTRATION.

### An Act to provide for the provisional administration of the Territory of Papua and that portion of the Territory of New Guinea no longer in enemy occupation.

[Assented to 3rd August, 1945.]
