An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of Moneys for the purposes of Housing.

[Assented to 1st October, 1958.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan (Housing) Act 1958.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, in accordance Authority to with the provisions of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act £35,810,000. 1911-1946, or in accordance with the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole Thirty-five million eight hundred and ten thousand pounds.

4. Moneys borrowed under this Act shall be issued and Application of moneys. applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purpose of making advances to States in accordance with the agreement executed in pursuance of the authority conferred by the Housing Agreement Act 1956.
