An Act to amend the Lighthouses Act 1911-1957.

[Assented to 24th October, 1961.]

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:----

1.--(1.) This Act may be cited as the Lighthouses Act 1961. Short title (2.) The Lighthouses Act 1911-1957,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Lighthouses Act 1911-1961.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed commenceby Proclamation.

3. Section nineteen B of the Lighthouses Act 1911–1957 is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:-

"19B. A person who, or the master of a ship which, damages Notice of a lighthouse or marine mark the property of the Commonwealth given." shall, as soon as practicable having regard to the means of communication available to him, report the damage to a prescribed officer.

Penalty: One hundred pounds.".
