

LIGHTHOUSES.

No. 63 of 1961.

An Act to amend the *Lighthouses Act 1911-1957*.

[Assented to 24th October, 1961.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Lighthouses Act 1961*.
(2.) The *Lighthouses Act 1911-1957*,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Lighthouses Act 1911-1961*.
Short title and citation.
2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.
Commencement.
3. Section nineteen B of the *Lighthouses Act 1911-1957* is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—
“ 19B. A person who, or the master of a ship which, damages a lighthouse or marine mark the property of the Commonwealth shall, as soon as practicable having regard to the means of communication available to him, report the damage to a prescribed officer.
Penalty: One hundred pounds.”
Notice of damage to given.
