An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of a certain Sum of Money.

[Assented to 6th October, 1942.]

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan Act (No. 3) 1942.

Short title.

- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it common comment. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, borrow, under the Authority to provisions of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1940, or \$200,000,000. under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Two hundred million pounds.

4. The amount borrowed may be issued and applied only for the which money expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations made, may be expended. or to be made, by law.

5. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any loan raised under the authority of this Act, or of any other Act, the \$200,000,000. sum of Two hundred million pounds for war purposes.
