LOAN APPROPRIATION.

No. 12 of 1921.

An Act to authorize the Issue and Application of the sum of Eight million three hundred and seventy thousand four hundred and six pounds.

[Assented to 7th December, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Loan Appropriation Act 1921.* Short title.

2. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any loan raised under the authority of any Loan Act the sum of Eight million three hundred and seventy thousand four hundred and six pounds for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act. Issue and application of £8,370,406.
