BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Land Tax Act 1920.

Short title.

2. Section three of the Land Tax Act 1918, as amended by the Application of Land Tax Act 1919, is further amended by inserting at the end assessment. thereof the words "and each financial year thereafter."

PASSPORTS.

An Act relating to Passports.

[Assented to 2nd December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Passports Act 1920.

Short title.

Definitions.

"Officer" means any person authorized by the Minister to exercise the powers conferred on officers by this Act, or a member of the Police Force, or an officer of Customs;
