Migration Act 1973

No. 16 of 1973

AN ACT

To amend the *Migration Act* 1958-1966 for the purpose of removing Restrictions on the Departure of Aboriginals from Australia.

[Assented to 11 April 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, the Senate and the House of Representatives of Australia, as follows:---

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Migration Act 1973.

(2) The Migration Act 1958-1966* is in this Act referred to as the ^{and} Principal Act.

(3) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Migration Act* 1958-1973.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencethe Royal Assent.

3. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words- Parts.

"Part III-Emigration of Certain Persons (Sections 59-64)."

and substituting the words-

"Part III-Emigration of Certain Children (Sections 59-63).".

4. The heading to Part III of the Principal Act is repealed and the Heading to Part III. following heading substituted:---

" PART III—EMIGRATION OF CERTAIN CHILDREN".

Definition. "59. In this Part, 'child' means a person under the age of seventeen years.".
