An Act to amend the Ministers of State Act 1952.

[Assented to 24th February, 1956.]

E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1956. Short title

- (2.) The Ministers of State Act 1952* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1952-1956.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "twenty" and inserting in its stead the word "twenty-two".
- 4. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the Salaries of words "Forty-one thousand pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "Forty-six thousand five hundred pounds".
