An Act to amend the Ministers of State Act 1952-1968.

[Assented to 18 May 1971]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Communication of the Commu the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1971.

(2.) The Ministers of State Act 1952-1968* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1952–1971.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives commencethe Royal Assent.

3. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word Number of Ministers. "twenty-six" and inserting in its stead the word "twenty-seven".

4. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words Salaries of "Two hundred and forty-five thousand, five hundred" and inserting in their stead the words "Two hundred and fifty-three thousand".
